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Who is Eligible?

A household is eligible for the Affordable Connectivity Program if the household income is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines, or if a member of the household meets at least *one* of the criteria below:

- Participates in certain assistance programs, such as SNAP, Medicaid, Federal Public Housing
- Assistance, SSI, WIC, or Lifeline;
- Participates in one of several Tribal specific programs, such as Bureau of Indian Affairs General
- Assistance, Tribal Head Start, Tribal TANF, or Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations;
- Participates in the National School Lunch Program or the School Breakfast Program, including through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision;
- Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year; or
- Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating broadband provider's existing low-income internet program.

Two-Steps to Enroll

1. Go to ACPBenefit.org to submit an application or print out a mail-in application; and
2. Contact your preferred participating provider to select a plan and have the discount applied to your bill.

Some providers may have an alternative application that they will ask you to complete.

Eligible households must **both apply for the program and contact a participating provider to select a service plan.**

April is National Safe Digging Month

Traditionally, April brings a ground swell of outdoor work which often includes digging. Whether it is a small project or a large home improvement project, National Safe Digging Month is a way to remind us all to call 811 before starting any digging project.

Did you know, every six minutes an underground utility line is damaged because someone decided to dig without first calling 811? The risk of injury, or even death is serious.

Beyond the devastating risks of death or injury, consider the costs of repair, fines and even inconvenience. From putting in a fence, planting a tree or building a deck, knowing where the power and water lines before you dig will save a lot of time, money and pain later.

HOW TO OBSERVE

1. Call 811 or go online to get a USA ticket **three days before** you plan to dig. All you have to do is give the address or general location of the project, when you plan to start, and how much digging you'll be doing.
2. Make sure you dig **parallel with the utility line** and use precautions when you are removing soil from near the utility line.
3. **Use smaller hand tools** while digging within 24 inches of the outer edge of underground utility lines.
4. Keep an eye out for signs of a natural gas leak. If you smell something similar to **rotten eggs, or hear hissing, whistling, or roaring**, it's likely a leak.
